



Application for the Eliot Community Service Department's Junior Counselor Program

There is a small application (see below) and mandatory interview for youth who are interested in this program. The responsibilities of the Junior Counselor include: assisting staff with setup and cleanup of activities, modeling responsible behavior, helping the staff plan events, and interacting with youth in a positive manner. The Junior Counselor will not be asked to discipline other youth or supervise an activity without another staff member present. **Junior Counselors will be working at the KidsPLAY program only.**

Requirements:

1. You must be entering the 9th grade or 10th grade to be eligible for this position.
2. Preference will be given to past Youth Bound participants.
3. Applications are due by April 10th. Interviews will be held at the end of April by appointment.
